I e-mailed Mayor Donna about the problem and she asked me to come to this meeting

I drive Moline quite often when going to and from Maple Court

Once you drive up Moline Street the road starts to curve

This is where the problem occurs

There are always cars parked on both sides of this street which makes it almost impossible to drive on your side of the road

This road is considered a two-way street but when driving this street only one vehicle can go through at a time.

This is rather inconvenient for the citizens whom drive on this street especially for the fact that it is considered a two-way

This is also a big safety concern because as driving down the road you don't always know who is coming because you can't see through all the cars.

Also we have these problems during the summer so what about the winter months?

If you ever slid on that road to the side you would go right into a car with no time to even think about correcting it due to the fact that the street is so narrow with the parking

I came here to state this issue with you but also ask you to please try and reconsider the way this street is laid out.
