Speeding Concerns – In General

Once we receive a concern about speeding, we add it to our speed trailer list for future placement. We also e-mail the patrol staff and ask for special enforcement of that area and the specifics of the concerns. We deal with many requests for special enforcement throughout the summer months as traffic speed increases. We encourage citizens to pick up “Slow Down” signs at the police department that are provided through the Safe Community Coalition.

Request for No Parking in the 200 Block East Jefferson Street

During the recent fire at Uniroyal on July 6th, the Fire Department had difficulty in access to the environmental equipment next to the building with their apparatus. Fortunately in this instance the fire was isolated and not spreading. If the fire was not contained and spreading, the limited access to the building could have been devastating.

Fire Chief Martin Lamers and I are requesting to have no parking on the south side of East Jefferson Street at South Forrest Street, from the east edge of the driveway access for Uniroyal and **east** 72 feet. The no parking area stops prior to the residence at 207 East Jefferson Street. This would be in front of the Uniroyal building and not in front of any residences. See photographs below.
