Division St. Park Riverbank Restoration

Several years ago the City Council approved funding of \$51,000 to restore and protect the riverbank in Division St. Park. The area between the Forton St. Bridge and the property to the south end of the park has lost several feet of shoreline due to high river flow over the years.

After two failed DNR grant attempts, we are still without a restoration of this area. River flow is not as damaging as it once was, with better communication with the controllers of flow up river.

We are still working to finish this project using the allocated funds. The River and Trails Task Force is a strong proponent of a more natural combination of vegetation and stone, compared to traditional rip rap.

On Tuesday, Aaron Steber, a Senior Project Scientist for Cardno, will be answering questions about this option for members of the River and Trails Task Force, Parks and Recreation Committee and Public Works Committee.

We hope to leave this meeting with a unified plan and a recommendation to the City Council so that we have a chance to complete this project in 2015.
