Call to Order

1. Call to order at 5:32 pm
2. January 9, 2017 Minutes: Approved by Jon with a second by Larry. Carried.
3. Communications:
  - a. Spring Clean Up April 22, 2017 at 9:00 am on Earth Day. Tom will ask Scouts for help and a notice will be posted in the paper.
  - b. Mandt Park Plan Update: The \$6,000 feasibility cost has been approved for the project. Tom shared a picture of a whitewater park in Manchester, Iowa that has benefitted that community with the idea of a similar park here. Tom has spoken to companies who build these parks. Discussion to continue.
  - c. Amundson Trail Update: Tom checked in with Skaalen Home again about the park dedication land with no update as of yet. Bob has sent follow-up letters to the two river homeowners with no response from either yet.

4. Bike Route Updates: Tom presented information to the Council with passage of the project. Signage can now be posted. A new development today is that the signs may need to follow County signage and Tom will explore the details. Further discussion at the next meeting. Tom also talked to the High School principal who wants an agreement to use the bike path on the north side of the school. They are asking for a blacktop strip around the blockades leading into and out of the area with the payment for the project covered by the City.
