



Trademark and Patent Marking Guidelines

OneD Material LLC is the owner of certain rights in the trademarks, service marks and/or trade names and all applications therefor (collectively, "Trademarks") identified below:

These trademarks are associated with the technology know-how and patent rights owned by OneD Material, and must only be used in accordance with the OneD Material guidelines.

Key requirements for correct trademark use:

1. Trademark Symbol:

- Always use the correct trademark symbol as provided electronically by OneD Material.
- You do not have to use trademark symbols in headlines unless there is no accompanying text, in which case you must use it.
- Use trademark symbols in superscript (i.e. [™] or [®]). However, you may use parentheses (TM) and (R) where this is not possible.
- Do not use trademark symbols after any product name, service name or technology name that is not a OneD Material trademark.

2. Approved Noun:

- Always use trademarks as adjectives, accompanied by an approved noun. A list of approved nouns can be provided for each OneD Material trademark in the OneD Material Trademark List.
- Never use a trademark as a noun, a verb, or in the possessive or plural form. Your use will probably be incorrect if the sentence does not make grammatical sense without the trademark included in it.
- Please note the special rule for referential use of OneD's trademarks in the section below entitled "Referential / Prohibited Use."

3. Trademark Notice:

- Always include the correct trademark notice for OneD Material's ownership of its trademarks in all materials.

4. Never alter OneD's trademarks in any way:

- Do not alter the spelling or form of OneD Material's trademarks by abbreviating them, creating acronyms, translating them, joining them to other words, symbols or numbers (either as one word or with a

hyphen - unless otherwise permitted), or using improper capitalization. However, permitted capitalization occurs when using a OneD Material word trademark in headlines, titles or text where all of the surrounding words are shown in uppercase characters. In this situation, you may use the relevant OneD Material trademark in uppercase characters, provided that such use complies with these guidelines.

Prohibited use of ONED's trademarks:

1. Do not use any ONED logo without written authorization from ONED. Do not use inaccurate or misleading nouns after ONED's trademarks. ONED's trademarks are used for specific products and services.
2. Do not use an ONED trademark, slogan or logo (or any part of an ONED trademark, slogan or logo) as part of another trademark, slogan, logo or other name. This includes but is not limited to a company name, trade name, product name, service name, technology name, standard, domain name, social media name or handle.
3. Do not register an ONED trademark, slogan or logo (or any part of an ONED trademark, slogan or logo) either alone or as part of another trademark or other name. This includes, but is not limited to a company name, trade name, product name, service name, technology name, standard, domain name, social media name or handle.
4. Do not use ONED's trademarks more prominently than your own trademarks, company name, trade name, product name, service name or other name. You should distinguish such names visually from any ONED trademark or other name.
5. Do not use ONED's trademarks to make fun of ONED or portray ONED in a negative way.
6. Do not use ONED's trademarks in any manner that expresses or implies that ONED has any affiliation, sponsorship, endorsement, certification, or approval of your product, service or company.
7. Do not use ONED's trademarks in false or misleading advertising.
8. Do not use ONED's trademarks in connection with any defamatory, scandalous, pornographic, or other objectionable materials.
9. Do not manufacture, advertise, sell, distribute or otherwise give away any merchandise items bearing any ONED trademark, logo or other name without an express written trademark license from ONED.
10. Do not imitate any element of ONED's logos, trade dress or product packaging.
