## Who We Are

Planet Bee Foundation is on a mission to change the world, one bee at a time. We are creating the next generation of environmental stewards by increasing awareness of the current bee crisis and engaging communities to take action. We work with schools, nonprofits, summer camps, environmental centers, community gardens and businesses to build long lasting care of the struggling honey bee and the environment by presenting hands-on, educational workshops.

## The Humble Honeybee Project is our eco-literacy program.

Each lesson is 50-60 minutes long, and consists of our uniquely designed, age appropriate and hands-on Bee Basics curriculum. Our programs are in line with the Next Generation Science Standards. We teach lessons for grades k-12.

When Planet Bee arrives on site, we set up in the garden or available outdoor space. We bring an observation hive and our activity table, as well as any additional stations we need. We lead students through a circuit of interactive activities and educational games focused on pollination and honeybees, and allow students to explore how they can make a difference for the planet.

Our activities are designed to help students think critically about the environment, honey bees, and pollinators' important role in the ecosystem. Our inquiry-based, interactive curriculum engages students with deeper learning and comprehension, inspire curiosity, and instill a love of our environment.

## Take it a step further – Do real research with your class.

Planet Bee is a proud partner with San Francisco State University. We are happy to offer schools an opportunity to participate in the ZomBee Watch Project, a national citizen science project. In this program, students will conduct real research over the course of a school year with the guidance of Planet Bee and SF State University interns. Their data is input into a national database, which is used by researchers to fight honey bee decline! This project is suitable for all grades.
