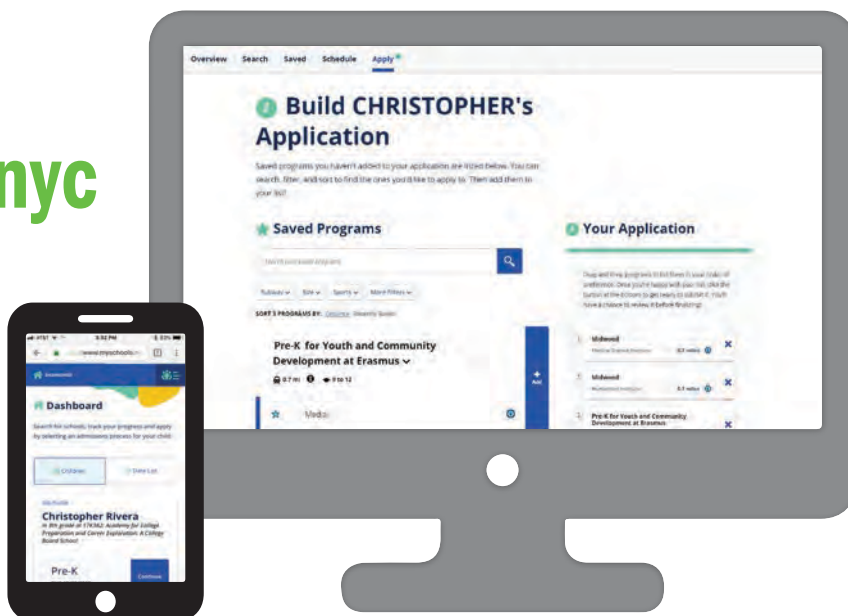

## TO PRE-K ADMISSIONS

New York City offers every four-year-old free, full-day, high-quality pre-K through the Pre-K for All program. All New York City families with children born in 2015 are eligible to participate in Pre-K for All for the 2019-2020 school year. Between **early February** and **March 15, 2019**, apply to pre-K by submitting a pre-K application. You can apply to up to 12 programs.

Use this admissions guide to learn about early childhood education options, how to apply to pre-K, and how children get pre-K offers. Find programs near you on our district maps. Then visit  **MySchools.nyc** to learn more about programs, select programs for your child's application, and apply.

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# WELCOME

## TO PRE-K ADMISSIONS

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### Language Supports

The Department of Education (DOE) provides a range of pre-K program options to ensure that all children—including Emergent Multilingual Learners (EMLLs), who are students whose home language is a language other than English—gain foundational language, literacy, cognitive, and social emotional skills. Some programs offer supports in English and the child’s home or target language. Learn more about these programs in **Section 3.2** of this guide.

### Special Education | [schools.nyc.gov/SpecialEducation](https://schools.nyc.gov/SpecialEducation)

All families with children born in 2015, including children with disabilities, may apply to pre-K programs for the 2019-2020 school year. Pre-K special education services are available for pre-K students with disabilities or delays in development that affect learning. These services are provided free of charge for eligible children, and many students can get their special education services at a general education pre-K program. If your child is showing delays, you can contact your local Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) to request an evaluation to learn if your child is eligible—find CPSEs for each district at [schools.nyc.gov/CSE](https://schools.nyc.gov/CSE). Unsure of your school district? Call **311**.

### Accessibility | [schools.nyc.gov/BuildingAccessibility](https://schools.nyc.gov/BuildingAccessibility)

The NYC Department of Education is committed to providing students with accessibility needs with a pre-K placement that allows them to access all relevant programs and services. Families of students with accessibility needs are encouraged to contact programs to understand how these programs will meet their needs, and to list accessible programs on their application. If your family does not receive an offer to an appropriately accessible program, please request a call from the Outreach Team at [nyc.gov/PreK](https://nyc.gov/PreK) to discuss other placement options. For more information, including definitions of fully and partially accessible buildings, visit our website. All programs that are fully or partially accessible are labeled respectively as  and  in the Program Information and Maps pages of this admissions guide.

### Students in Temporary Housing | [schools.nyc.gov/STH](https://schools.nyc.gov/STH)

Families in temporary housing with children born in 2015 or 2016 should apply to pre-K, 3-K, or other early childhood programs even if their housing situation is uncertain. Students in temporary housing, including those living in shelter or with another person due to financial situation, are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization records) in order to participate in an admissions process or enroll in a pre-K or 3-K program.

New York City offers every four-year-old child free, full-day, high-quality pre-K through the Pre-K for All program. We also offer 3-K for All programs for three-year-olds in every borough—learn more in **Section 7.1**.

High-quality pre-K helps prepare children for kindergarten and gives them a strong start in school and life. Pre-K for All classrooms are full of joy and discovery as children learn to problem-solve, ask questions, and explore the world around them.

## 1.1 Pre-K for All | For Four-Year-Olds

In pre-K classrooms across New York City, teachers are helping children develop their minds and their sense of wonder. Pre-K programs run five days a week from September to June. Most are full-day, or six hours and 20 minutes long. In these high-quality programs, children are in a safe learning environment with opportunities to explore, play, create, and participate in engaging activities as they interact with other children and teaching staff.

All New York City families with children born in 2015 can apply. Submit a pre-K application between early February and **March 15, 2019**. You can add up to 12 programs to your application. In May, you will get one offer. Pre-register at the program to accept your offer.

## 1.2 Who Can Apply?

Your child must be a current New York City resident who was born in 2015 to start pre-K in September 2019. Pre-K admissions is open to all children of this age, including current 3-K for All students at DOE public schools, Pre-K Centers, and NYC Early Education Centers; children attending three-year-old programs at charter, private, and parochial schools; children with accessibility needs; children with disabilities; children who are Emergent Multilingual Learners (EMLLs); and children in temporary housing. Children currently attending a three-year-old program (including 3-K for All) at a location that offers Pre-K for All still need to apply to pre-K.

If you move to New York City during the school year and need to find a pre-K seat for your child now, visit **[schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents](https://schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents)**.



### Tip:

Charter schools are free public schools that operate independently from the NYC Department of Education. Pre-K programs at charter schools have a separate application process, but any student eligible for admission to a Pre-K for All program is eligible for admission to a charter school. If you would like to apply to a charter school, please contact that school directly to learn how to apply. You can find charter elementary schools near you in the maps of this admissions guide—for more information, visit **[schools.nyc.gov/Charters](https://schools.nyc.gov/Charters)** or call **212-374-5419**.

## 1.3 3-K for All | For Three-Year-Olds

If you have a child born in 2016, you can apply this winter for your child to start 3-K in September 2019. New York City now offers free, full-day, high-quality 3-K for All programs in all five boroughs. All New York City families may apply to 3-K programs, and offers are made based on each program's admissions priorities. Learn more in **Section 7.1** and at **[nyc.gov/3K](https://nyc.gov/3K)**.

## 1.4 Other Early Education Options

New York City also offers hundreds of free or low-cost child care or educational programs for children from six weeks to four years old. These programs have income or other eligibility requirements. If you qualify, your child can begin a program anytime during the year. Learn more in **Section 7.1** and at **[nyc.gov/EarlyLearn](https://nyc.gov/EarlyLearn)**.

## 2.0 Apply to Pre-K

Apply to pre-K between early February and **March 15, 2019**. Only a child's primary custodial parent or guardian can submit their pre-K application, and only one application can be submitted per child.

### 2.1 How to Apply

You can apply one of three ways.

MySchools is an online directory of New York City public schools and early childhood programs as well as a personalized application for your child.

- Apply anytime—this option is available 24 hours a day.
- Apply in English, Spanish, Chinese, Bengali, Russian, Arabic, Urdu, Haitian Creole, Korean, or French.
- Apply by **March 15, 2019**, at 11:59pm.

##### By phone at 718-935-2009

- Call us Monday through Friday from 8am to 6pm.
- Apply by phone in over 200 languages. If you speak a language other than English, ask for an interpreter.
- Apply by **March 15, 2019**, at 6pm.

##### In person at a Family Welcome Center

- Visit us Monday through Thursday from 8am to 5pm and Friday from 8am to 3pm—locations are listed on the inside back cover of this guide.
- Apply in person in over 200 languages. If you speak a language other than English, ask for an interpreter.
- Apply by **March 15, 2019**, at 3pm.



##### Tip:

Pre-K admissions is not first come, first served, and you can make changes to your application anytime before the **March 15** deadline. All applications submitted by this deadline are treated the same based on admissions priorities—learn more in **Sections 4.3-4.5**.

### 2.2 Families with Multiple Children Applying to Pre-K

If you have more than one child applying to pre-K and want your children to attend the same program, apply for both or all children at the same time.



## 3.0 Learn about Pre-K Programs

When you complete your child's pre-K application, you are applying to pre-K programs located at a school or center. Most pre-K providers offer only one program called a full-day program. However, some pre-K providers may also offer a Dual Language program or a half-day program. Learn more about Dual Language programs in **Section 3.2**. Contact pre-K providers directly about applying to their half-day programs.

### 3.1 Three Pre-K Program Settings

Our Pre-K for All programs are hosted in three different settings:

1.



#### **DOE public schools.**

Many of our DOE public elementary schools offer pre-K programs.

2.



**Pre-K Centers.** Also run by DOE staff, our Pre-K Centers only serve grades before kindergarten. These programs are located either in existing school buildings or at other DOE sites.

3.



**NYC Early Education Centers (NYCEECs).** These are community-based organizations or school-based providers that contract with us or with the Administration for Children's Services (ACS) to provide pre-K. Carefully evaluated and selected, these programs are supported by the Division of Early Childhood Education. Some NYC Early Education Centers have flexibility in how they choose to schedule program hours, and they may provide optional program hours in the middle of the day or on weekends or holidays. Use MySchools ([MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)) and contact programs directly to learn more.



#### **Tip:**

Your child may have priority to attend pre-K at certain programs in DOE public schools or Pre-K Centers in the district where you live and/or where their siblings go to school. NYC Early Education Centers also give priority to current students and children from families who get social services from the organization that runs the center. Learn more about how we make offers to each program type in **Section 4.0**.

### 3.2 Dual Language Programs and Language Supports

Some DOE public schools, Pre-K Centers, and NYC Early Education Centers also offer a **Dual Language** program. In these programs, students are taught in two languages: English and a target language determined by community need. The goal of a Dual Language program is for students to be able to read, write, and speak in both English and the target language. Learn more about specific Dual Language programs in MySchools and by contacting pre-K programs directly.

Some NYC Early Education Centers' pre-K programs offer enhanced **Language Supports**, which include:

- A staff member who is fluent in the target language, who is available to support families
- Interpretation services at family meetings
- Translated communications in the target language
- Teaching staff who support the continued development of both English and the target language during instruction

These programs may give an admissions priority to students whose home language is the same as a language supported by that program. Learn which pre-K programs offer these supports in which languages in MySchools, and contact programs directly to learn more.  **MySchools.nyc** includes more detailed information on every Pre-K for All program, including detailed program contact information, such as email addresses and websites; transportation options; grades served; school or program size; which groups of students got offers to the program last year; and much more!

You can also use MySchools to do the following:

- ☐ Find the most up-to-date information on all pre-K programs.
- ☐ Find the most up-to-date listing of pre-K options, including programs added after the publication of this book.
- ☐ Learn your school district.
- ☐ Learn if you have a zoned school.



### Tip:


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Charter school and half-day pre-K programs are included in this book and in MySchools, but they have a separate admissions processes—call these programs directly to learn how to apply.

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## 3.4 Program Quality

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The Pre-K Quality Snapshot contains data from program assessments and from the NYC School Survey. It can help you understand different aspects of quality at programs across New York City. You can view any program's Pre-K Quality Snapshot at  **MySchools.nyc**.



### Tip:

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Learn more about program quality by visiting pre-K programs, asking teachers and leaders questions, and talking to community members and other families about their experiences in pre-K. The activity in **Section 5.0** can help you build a list of questions.

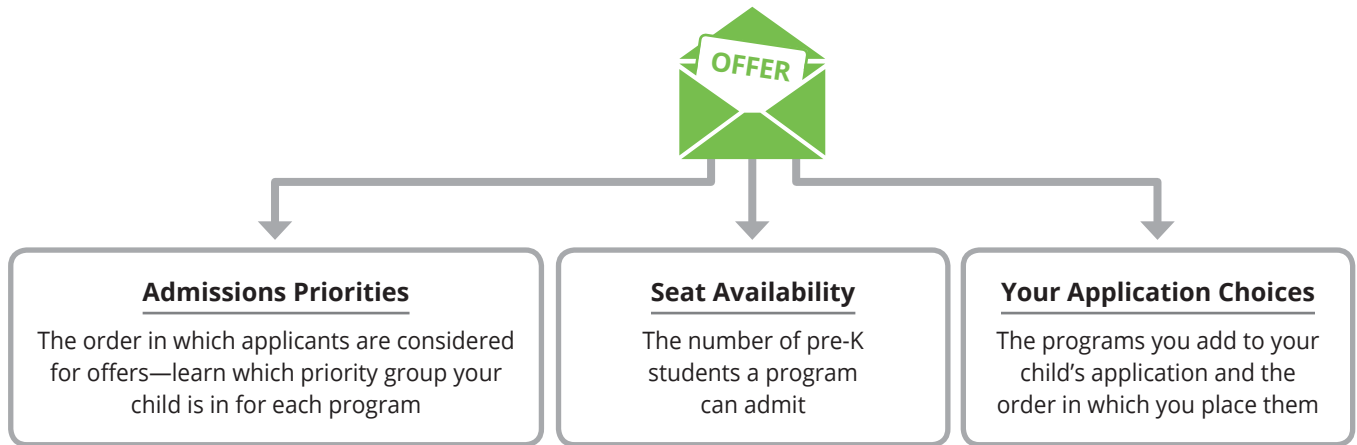

**Tip:**

In **Sections 4.1-4.5** and the activity that follows, you'll learn more about how to build a successful pre-K application and choose programs that are more likely than others to give your child an offer.

There's a pre-K seat for every child born in 2015! How can you know your child's chances of getting an offer from one of your favorite programs? A number of factors play a role in how children get pre-K offers:



### 4.1 Your Choices on the Application

The programs that you add to your child's application and the order in which you place them help determine where your child goes to pre-K.

1. Choose up to 12 programs that you'd like your child to attend.
2. Add these programs to their pre-K application.
3. Place these program choices on the application from your favorite to least favorite, with your favorite program at the top.

Your child will get an offer to the pre-K program that is your highest possible choice considering seat availability and admissions priorities. If your child does not get an offer to a program from their application, they will get an offer to the closest available program to where you live.



#### Tip:

Some pre-K providers offer more than one program, so be sure to add the correct program—such as a Dual Language program—to your application.

### 4.2 Seat Availability

Pre-K programs vary in size, and many programs have more applicants than seats. When a program can't make offers to all applicants, it makes offers based on which students have the highest admissions priority to attend that program.

### 4.3 Types of Admissions Priorities

Your child has a better chance of getting into some programs than others. A program's admissions priorities are the order in which they consider applicants for offers.

- Students are considered in priority groups, and all students in the first priority group are considered first.
- If seats are available, students in the second priority group will be considered next, and so on.

Program demand varies greatly. Some programs admit applicants from most or all priority groups, while others only admit applicants from their first priority group.

### Current Student Priority

If your child currently attends a 3-K for All or another three-year-old program and you would like them to remain at that school or center for pre-K, be sure to note in their application that they are a current student.

### Sibling Priority

If your child has a sibling at a program that you add to your child's pre-K application, your child has a higher chance of getting an offer from that program. A sibling is defined as an applicant's brother or sister. This includes half-brothers, half-sisters, step-brothers, step-sisters, foster brothers, and foster sisters who live in the same household. Sibling priority only applies when the child is currently pre-registered or enrolled at that program or school in any grade and will be enrolled in that school for the 2019-2020 school year. For DOE public schools, this includes students enrolled in District 75 programs in the same building.



#### Tip:

If you also have older children applying to kindergarten for fall 2019 and you haven't received your kindergarten offer, include each sibling's information and the school you would like them to attend together. Your younger child will get sibling priority for pre-K at the school where your older child gets their kindergarten offer if you have listed that school's pre-K program on your younger child's pre-K application.

### Zoned Priority

Most families in New York City have a zoned elementary school. This means that students who live in the zone, or area around a school, have an admissions priority to attend that school. If you have a zoned DOE public school that offers a pre-K program, your child has priority to attend that program.

Non-zoned schools are DOE public schools that do not have zones. Districts 1, 7, and 23 have only non-zoned schools—students living in these districts have priority to attend all schools in the district.

### District Priority

Your child has an admissions priority to attend pre-K programs at DOE public schools and Pre-K Centers in the school district where your family lives.



#### Tip:





Use MySchools ([MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)) to look up any school's admissions priorities and learn who got offers last year. This information will help you know your child's chances of getting an offer to a particular program.

The higher priority your child has to attend a program, the higher the chance that your child will get an offer to that program.

If a program made offers to a specific group of students last year, they may be able to make offers to this group again. For example, if a pre-K program at a zoned DOE public school made offers last year to some applicants without siblings, they may also be able to make offers to applicants without siblings this year.

#### 4.4 Admissions Priorities for DOE Public Schools, Pre-K Centers, and NYC Early Education Centers

#### 4.5 Diversity in Admissions

Pre-K programs across the city are participating in an effort to increase diversity by giving admissions priorities to students who qualify for free and reduced lunch (FRL), students in temporary housing (STH), Emergent Multilingual Learners (EMLLs), and other groups. The current list of pre-K programs participating in diversity pilots is available at [schools.nyc.gov/DiversityAdmissions](https://schools.nyc.gov/DiversityAdmissions).

\* If there are more current student applicants than there are available seats in a pre-K program, current students will receive offers to that pre-K program based on admissions priorities in the order outlined in the 2nd-7th priorities.

#### Tip:

If programs admitted students from your child's priority group last year, it's more likely that applicants from that same group will get offers this year, too. However, if last year's students in that group did not get offers, it's less likely that this year's students in that priority group will get offers.

## 4.6 Additional Eligibility Criteria

Some programs have additional eligibility criteria for applicants. Use MySchools ( **MySchools.nyc**) and the Program Information and Maps pages in this book to learn which programs have eligibility requirements in some or all classrooms.

### Programs Serving Emergent Multilingual Learners (EMLLs)

Dual Language programs and pre-K programs that offer Language Supports give priority to students based on their home language.

### Programs Serving Students with Disabilities

If your child has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) that recommends a Special Education Itinerant Teacher (SEIT) and/or Related Services, they can receive these services at any general education Pre-K for All program. Students recommended for Special Class or Special Class in an Integrated Setting (SCIS) will work their CPSE to receive a seat in an appropriate program.


Please note, some programs may only have SCIS classrooms. Due to classroom ratio requirements, children recommended for SEIT and/or Related Services may not be able to enroll in these programs. To find out what special education services a program offers, review the program's information in MySchools or call the program directly before applying.

Learn more about how the DOE serves students with disabilities at [schools.nyc.gov/SpecialEducation](https://schools.nyc.gov/SpecialEducation).


### Programs with Income and Other Eligibility Requirements

Some NYC Early Education Centers may have eligibility criteria related to household income, home language, home address, government services received, and/or child care needs because they have EarlyLearn seats.

- All or some seats in a program may have EarlyLearn eligibility requirements. Use the Program Information and Maps pages in this book to see if some or all seats at a program are set aside for applicants with these eligibilities.
- Programs that get this additional funding may also provide free or low-cost extended day services to eligible families; these extended care hours are typically until around 6pm.

Find out more about these programs in MySchools ( **MySchools.nyc**), and contact NYC Early Education Center programs directly to learn about additional eligibility requirements for enrolling your child, what schedules are offered (including the first day of their pre-K program), and whether there are any fees for subsidized services. Apply to these programs only if your family meets their eligibility criteria. You can also check if you are eligible for ACS programs by visiting [nyc.gov/CCE](https://nyc.gov/CCE) or calling **311**.

### Programs with Single-Gender Options

Pre-K providers that offer single-gender programs or classrooms are noted in MySchools ( **MySchools.nyc**). If you have questions about any of these programs, contact them before submitting your child's application.

## 5.0 Go to Events and Visit Programs

Create an admissions calendar to keep track of pre-K admissions events, as well as open houses.

### 5.1 Pre-K Admissions Events

Consider attending a pre-K admissions event starting in February 2019. At these events, you can learn about the pre-K admissions process, learn how to complete your application in MySchools ([MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)), and ask questions. The pre-K admissions events for different boroughs take place on different dates. Check [nyc.gov/PreK](https://nyc.gov/prek) to learn which date(s) to attend a pre-K admissions event near you.

### 5.2 Visit Programs

Visiting a program is the best way to explore how good a fit it may be for your child. It's also a great way to see how long the trip is from home, and to think about how your child would get to that program each day. Contact pre-K programs directly to find out if they have special events, open houses, or tours. The calendar at [nyc.gov/PreK](https://nyc.gov/prek) is another way to find a program's open house dates. In the space provided, make a list of open houses you plan to attend.

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## 6.0 Get and Accept Your Pre-K Offer

In May, you will get your child's pre-K offer. This offer will tell you where your child will go to pre-K in the fall, as well as if your child was placed on any waitlists.

### 6.1 Pre-Registration

Accept your child's pre-K offer by pre-registering at the program where you got an offer. Pre-registration secures your child's pre-K seat at that program.

Contact the program to set up a time to pre-register. Then bring your child and all required documents to secure your child's seat. Use the checklist below to make sure you have everything you need:

#### PRE-K PRE-REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

- ☐ The child who you are registering
- ☐ Proof of your child's age (child's birth certificate, passport, or baptism record)
- ☐ Your child's immunization records, if available
- ☐ Two documents verifying proof of address: find examples of acceptable documents at [schools.nyc.gov/PreK](https://schools.nyc.gov/PreK), and scroll down to view the online Pre-Registration Checklist



**Tip:**

Students in temporary housing are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization) in order to enroll. Programs must provisionally pre-register the student and then work with a DOE representative to obtain documentation.

### 6.2 Waitlist Offers

When a pre-K program has more applicants than seats, a waitlist is created for that program. Your child will be automatically added to the waitlist for any program that you placed higher on your child's application than the program where they got an offer. For example, if your child got an offer to attend the program you listed third on their application, they will automatically be added to the waitlist for your first- and second-choice programs.

Waitlists use the same admissions priorities described in **Section 4.0**. Programs will contact you directly if they are able to offer your child a seat from the waitlist.

### 6.3 Students Who Move During the Admissions Process

If you move to New York City during the pre-K admissions process, you can call **718-935-2009**, email [ESEnrollment@schools.nyc.gov](mailto:ESEnrollment@schools.nyc.gov), or visit a Family Welcome Center for help with getting an application for your child. Family Welcome Center locations are located on the inside back cover of this guide.

If you're a current New York City resident who moves to a new New York City address during the pre-K admissions process, you can call **718-935-2009** or visit a Family Welcome Center to update your information and talk about changes to your pre-K application or program. Your child's priority to attend certain programs may change if you move.



## 6.4 Transportation


Enrollment in a pre-K program does not include school bus service. Only students who are eligible for specialized transportation will get bus service.

# 7.0 Learn About Options for Three-Year-Olds

## 7.1 3-K Programs

3-K for All brings free, full-day, high-quality education to three-year-old children in New York City in a growing number of communities.

All New York City families with children born in 2016 can apply for 3-K. Submit a 3-K application between early February and **April 18, 2019**. Sign up for the 3-K admissions email list at [schools.nyc.gov/Connect](https://schools.nyc.gov/Connect) to get updates and key date reminders. You can apply to up to 12 programs. In May, you will get your 3-K results, which may include an offer. Pre-register at the program to accept an offer.

Use MySchools ( [MySchools.nyc](https://MySchools.nyc.gov)) when the application period opens in February to:

- Explore your child's 3-K for All program options—check back frequently, as we will be adding new programs all spring.
- Build and submit your 3-K application by the **April 18** deadline.

Visit [nyc.gov/3K](https://nyc.gov/3K) anytime to:

- Find the most up-to-date information on 3-K admissions.
- Request a call from our Outreach Team.

## 7.2 Who Can Apply to 3-K?

Your child must be a current New York City resident who was born in 2016 to start 3-K in September 2019. 3-K admissions is open to all children of this age, including children with accessibility needs, children with disabilities, Emergent Multilingual Learners (EMLLs), and children in temporary housing.

New York City residents in any district are eligible to apply to all 3-K for All programs citywide, but some students have an admissions priority to attend certain programs based on where they live, their home language, or other factors.

## 7.3 Other Early Education Options

In addition to our Pre-K for All and 3-K for All programs, New York City also provides hundreds of free or low-cost child care and education programs for six-week-old to four-year-old children through EarlyLearn. Eligibility for these programs is based on your family's income, size, and needs. If your family qualifies, your child can begin a program at any point during the year.

These programs offer:

- Quality programming and family engagement
- Opportunities for children to play, learn, and build the skills that get them ready for kindergarten
- Safe, positive learning environments
- Care five days a week, up to 10 hours a day, 12 months a year
- Experienced and certified teachers

- Free, nutritious meals and snacks
- Care for children with special needs
- Access to community resources such as dental and medical screenings

## Program Types
