



## WHO TO CONTACT IF I SUSPECT HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

**\*\*\* DO NOT PERSONALLY INTERVENE. REPORT YOUR CONCERNS TO THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES.\*\*\***

If you witness what you believe may be human trafficking and it's important that a police officer responds right away (impending physical harm, offender/victims leaving the area, etc.) Call 911

If you observe a situation that you suspect might be human trafficking but an immediate response is not required, you have two options:

WEST DISTRICT: 1710 McKenna Blvd, Jay Lengfeld, Captain Call 266-5938

The area to the west of Speedway, Nakoma Rd, and Seminole Highway. It extends south to Highway PD, and is bordered roughly on the west by the Beltline Highway.

SOUTH DISTRICT: 825 Hughes Place, Joe Balles, Captain Call 266-5938

The areas of the City of Madison which are south of the south shoreline of Lake Mendota and the areas south of Regent St and Speedway. The South District is bounded to the east by Monona Ave and on the West by Seminole Highway.

CENTRAL DISTRICT: 211 South Carroll Street, Mary Schauf, Captain Call 266-4316

The central area of the city and is bounded to the west and south by UW Hospitals, Campus Dr, Old University Ave, Breese Terrace and Regent St. The east boundaries are Fordem Ave, First St, East Washington Ave, Winnebago St and Atwood Ave.

EAST DISTRICT: 809 South Thompson Drive, Tom Snyder, Captain Call 266-4887

The area South of Lien Rd, and East of Interstate Highway 39/90. It is bordered on the west by Lake Monona, and the City of Monona. It also includes a newly annexed area East of Highway 90 along Highway 12-18.

NORTH DISTRICT: 2033 Londonderry Drive, Cameron McLay, Captain Call 243-5258

Bounded by Lake Mendota and Maple Bluff to the West, East Washington Avenue to Lien Road to the south, and Highway 90-94 to the East. It also includes the newly annexed area East of Hwy. 90-94 and North of Highway 151 to the Sun Prairie border.
