Category Descriptions

CLEAN EMISSIONS

Zero Emission Vehicles... do not create pollutants. Examples: bicycles, solar, electric, wind & self-propelled

ANIMALS WITH OR W/O DRAWN VEHICLE

Any animal entry; horses, goats, llamas, dogs, etc. pulling or not pulling a cart/buggy type vehicle. Entrants are responsible for all animal wastes along parade route & in staging & disbanding areas.

COLOR GUARD

Any unit that carries the flags/colors of the USA and wishes to compete. (Walking, vehicle or mounted)

EQUESTRIAN CLASSES

- **Single Equestrian Mounted**
- **Group Equestrian Mounted**

ANTIQUE & CLASSIC AUTOS

Must be in collector condition & 30 or more years old.

FLOATS

Fully decorated structure/vehicle that depicts the parade theme: **“2019 “It Takes a Village to Blossom”**. Floats may have fresh floral, natural materials or artificial materials. In judging, points will be added for decorated truck cabs and tow vehicles.

- **COMMERCIAL FLOAT** A unit which carries and promotes the name, logo and/or product, or other insignia, of a commercial for-profit business.
- **NON-PROFIT** Are not commercial, nonprofit organizations, academic schools, veterans groups and individuals.

NOVELTY

These are based on innovation, uniqueness, costume, decorations and theme. Humor is recommended!

YOUTH

Single or group of youths, under the age of 18.

- Elementary School ~ Highest grade is 6th

General Rules for Entries

Safety Rules for All

- 1. PARADE PARTICIPANTS MAY NOT THROW ANY ITEM FROM THEIR UNIT, FLOAT OR AUTO.** Walkers, affiliated with an entry, may distribute appropriate items such as product samples, to the audience at the curb but should not encourage the audience to leave the curb or move into the street.
- 2.** Parade participants may not jump onto or off of any float or moving vehicle and may not interfere with any other unit in the parade.
- 3.** Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age. All motorized vehicles must submit proof of liability insurance with entry form.
- 4.** Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to and during the parade will be removed from the line-up.
- 5.** Floats must have hand holds or barriers to secure riders in the event of sudden stops or starts, chairs or seating must be attached to float -bed.
- 6.** All floats must carry fire extinguishers with minimum ratings 2-A, 10-B:C.
- 7.** All individuals on self-propelled and motorized vehicles must wear helmets as the law requires.
- 8.** This is an ALL FORWARD MOTION PARADE. Performing groups should choreograph routine to maintain forward motion at the appropriate pace.
- 9.** ONLY paid prior applications are allowed in the parade. **NO "DAY OF" ENTRIES.**
- 10.** All entrants and participants must cooperate with the parade organizers and volunteers and line up as directed or risk expulsion from the parade. AND, MOST OF ALL HAVE FUN!
