

New Voter ID Requirements

As of July 1, 2014 you must show a photo ID to vote on Election Day.

Don't Have a Photo ID? Get a FREE VA Voter ID.

If you are a registered voter and don't have one of the acceptable forms of ID listed, you can go to any local Office of Election in Virginia to apply for a FREE Voter ID.

All ID's *MUST* Include Your Name and Photo
IDs that have been expired for more than 1 year will NOT be accepted Election Day.

When you register to vote, you will need to know the last 4 digits of your social security number, and bring a valid form of ID.
