A Consultant Team led by Design Workshop, Inc. is developing a Corridor Master Plan for the Eastern Sierra US Highway 395 Corridor Enhancement Program. The study corridor includes US 395 from the Kern/San Bernardino county line on the south to the California/Nevada state line on the north, as well as State Route 14 (SR 14) corridor from US 395 on the north to the northern SR 58/SR 14 intersection in Mojave on the south. Together, these highways provide crucial links between Eastern Sierra communities and destinations, as well as links to nearby cities.

An important element in developing the Master Plan is to gain a clear understanding of the transportation functions and existing conditions of these highways. As part of the Consultant Team, LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. prepared a background report, which provided information for future decision-making regarding the overall Enhancement Program. Information was gathered through site visits, data gathering from state and local agencies, and through public workshops. The background report presented existing transportation conditions throughout the corridor including roadway configuration, vehicle and truck volumes, traffic safety, transit, and bicycle and pedestrian activity. The report reviewed current plans and projects and included additional detail regarding the current status of highway issues in communities throughout the corridor. This background information can be used as a guide for future decisions regarding possible treatments and alterations.
