REFERENCE

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LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. was retained to develop a transportation plan for the Park City Municipal Corporation. The plan focused on providing the local public transportation system for the 2002 Winter Olympics while also providing an effective long-range transit strategy. LSC worked with Salt Lake Organizing Committee staff and consultants to evaluate specific venues and schedules on a day-by-day basis. Transportation networks for each of the four key Olympics traveler groups (Athletes, Olympic Family, Media, and Attendees) were developed. These networks included enhanced public transit services, charter bus operations, parking strategies, pedestrian corridor enhancements, Intelligent Transportation Strategies, and public information plans.

This plan also provides a guide for transportation related capital improvements for Park City as a means of implementing the Park City General Plan. Working with City staff and a series of citizen participation workshops, goals and policies were developed to guide the direction of the transportation plan. LSC then developed a transportation plan capable of accommodating projected land use growth in an area, which currently experiences intermittent traffic congestion. The final transportation plan identified a combination of transit improvements, modification of parking layout and supply, construction of an intermodal transfer facility, and improvements in the roadway network necessary to maintain acceptable

levels of transport for the 2002 Winter Games as well as implementation of the Park City General Plan.
