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Last updated in 1996, Calaveras County is currently updating the countywide General Plan. While Mintier/Harnish was retained to conduct the remainder of the update, LSC Transportation Consultants was retained to prepare the Circulation Element and to conduct the transportation impacts analysis for CEQA. Key elements of LSC's work consisted of:

- Documentation of existing transportation conditions, including extensive traffic counts, summary of available bicycle and pedestrian counts, and summary of existing transit ridership, airport utilization, and truck activity.
- Evaluation of existing roadway and intersection level of service.
- Evaluation of level of service for four General Plan land use alternatives, and assessment of measures necessary to address deficiencies.
- Development of new potential circulation policies.
- Development of circulation diagrams.
- Review and refinement of draft roadway and bicycle/pedestrian facility design guidelines.
- Identification of strategies to address new California requirements for General Plans, including climate change regulations.
- Preparation of the Administrative Review Draft Circulation Element.

The County is currently working on the Draft Land Use Maps.
