The Calaveras County Council of Governments retained LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. to prepare a Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) for the Calaveras County area under expanded and updated requirements. This document encompassed a wide range of tasks, including the following:

- A review of regional transportation and demographic characteristics
- An analysis of policy and planning issues, goals and objectives and performance measures, and potential plan elements.
- An extensive outreach program to various elements of the community, including Native American and low-income residents.
- Coordination and input from governmental entities in Calaveras and surrounding counties.
- Evaluation of plan alternatives.
- Development of project lists identifying transportation improvements to be accomplished over a 20-year period.
- Definition of a financial plan to accomplish the goals, objectives and programs of the RTP.
- Discussion of the global warming considerations associated with the RTP.

In addition, LSC prepared a Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact under the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. The RTP was subsequently adopted by the CCOG Board of Directors.
