Materials List

Bring the following materials to class:

- 2 Japanese barens for printmaking
- Subtractive mark-making tools to use on HOTbox – bring a few of any of these: Colour Shapers tools “Cup Chisel firm” (any sizes) and Colour Shaper “Wide” painting tool firm curve 1.5 – 3” – these are favorites. Plus any of these: Silicone bowl scraper, cooking spatula, old credit cards, squeegee, Catylist tools etc. **No metal tools, they scratch the plate.**
- Brushes, assorted, to use with India ink (no wax)
- Optional: surface thermometer – infrared is preferred
- Optional: found tools: odd tools/sticks, screening/mesh, plastic jar tops, any texture stuff – whatever you think may work with drawing/stamping, mark-making expressively with India ink, or with encaustic on the Roland HOTbox.
- Optional: cardboard tube 30” long for paper (for getting your work back home)
- Old shoes, cover-up – we will freely sling ink around!

Materials fee of \$50 covers materials (listed below) provided by Castle Hill, instructors, and sponsors.

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Rags, gloves, blue tape
- Encaustic medium
- HOTboxes, heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons

Instructor will provide the following materials for shared use:

- India ink
- Eastern papers, including Masa, Mulberry, Kozo
- Mops, brooms, large brushes

We are sorry but you cannot put contaminated liquids down the drains or dump any materials on Castle Hill premises. All cleaning products and contaminated liquid - paint water, solvents, etc. - need to go home with you.
