Materials List

Bring the following materials to class:

- Natural bristle brushes - Hake brushes or hog bristle brushes from a hardware store. **No synthetics – they will melt!**
- Apron/work shirt

Optional materials:

- Collage materials (i.e. fabric, papers, tissues, leaves, etc.)
- Inkjet or laser photocopies for transfer, on cheap copy paper
- Scissors
- Carving/scraping tools
- Tins for mixing encaustic paint (washed out pet food tins, foil tins, etc.)
- Additional painting supports suitable for encaustic – must be rigid and absorbent. For example:
 - Encausticbord
 - Solid wood panel, untempered Masonite, plywood or luan
 - Heavy watercolor paper glued to board
 - Canvas over wood panel

Materials fee of \$20 covers materials (listed below) provided by Castle Hill, instructors, and sponsors.

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Encaustic paint and medium
- Rags, blue tape, gloves
- Heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons

Instructor will provide the following materials:

- Three prepared panels
- Collage materials
- Carving and scraping tools, mark-making materials
