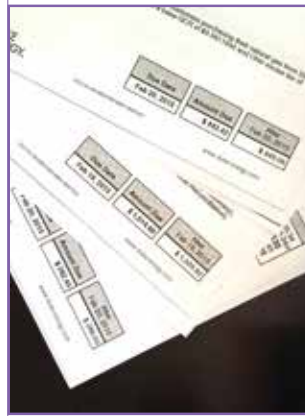
If you are one of our longtime supporters, you helped make a difference in his life. A once wounded child now carries wounded soldiers back to safety.
