FOLLOW UP EXERCISE:

Simply reflect on and discuss the following questions posed in this week’s message:

First read James 1:22-27. If you have time, read the entire book of James 😊

James writes, “Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.”

Do you believe he is saying that we (the church and individually) need to specifically care for orphans and widows? Or do you believe “orphans and widows” is used figuratively to simply describe those in distress or need?

FAMILY TIME

Read James 1:22-27 with your children. Ask their opinion on what they believe James is saying about caring for others. Talk as a family about ways they can begin to put their faith in action by meeting the needs of people in distress.
