Mission The George W. Anderson, Jr. Award may be awarded to graduate students studying in the School of Architecture who demonstrate, through their work, "an exceptional level of attention to detail AND dedication to beneficially impacting the community." A maximum of two awards may be awarded to qualifying students at the discretion of the selection committee.

Application Submission Requirements

1. Completed Application Form
2. Digital documentation of a completed design project
3. 3. 250-word essay
4. A presentation of your submission (*Pecha Kucha style) is also required. (See announcement for date and time)

Project Format Please submit a 250-word narrative that describes how your dedication to the project benefited the community. The documentation should call attention to the craft and detailing of the work. Designs are not to be new designs, but are expected to be designs that have been completed to date. The application form, digital representation of the project and 250-word essay must be submitted via electronic format.

Selection Process The selection committee consisting of Stephen Lee, Omer Akin, Erica Cochran, Jeremy Ficca and Darlene Covington-Davis will determine the recipients. For 2016 there will be a 1st place award in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (**\$3000**) and a 2nd place award in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (**\$2000**).
