## ARCHITECTURE SUPPLIES FOR FIRST YEAR

You will need a number of supplies for your first year of studying architecture at Carnegie Mellon.

**Incoming first-year architecture students are strongly advised to purchase the Architecture Supply Toolkit from the Carnegie Mellon University Art Store to best prepare you for your studies in architecture.** Purchasing the entire Architecture Supply Toolkit is highly recommended as the supplies in this toolkit are necessary for your first year drawing and studio courses and continuing throughout your time as an architecture student. Even if you already have some of the supplies listed on the next page, it may be a good idea to buy the entire kit anyway to take advantage of the package discount. They are also conveniently packaged and available for pick-up from the CMU Art Store during Orientation Week. (*Note: Individual items cannot be purchased at a discount; the entire kit must be purchased for the discount.*)

You will need to purchase the attached list of supplies for your first year in Architecture. **A discounted price is available to all First Year Architecture students who purchase the Architecture Supply Toolkit from the university Art Store by Tuesday, August 1.** The School of Architecture strongly recommends that you take advantage of this offer since these materials will be needed to complete your architecture studies.
