Bold and confrontational, but filled with hope, Greg Auerbach makes artwork that explores the political, social, and environmental issues of our day, and our history.

With irony, conviction, and an ability to make uncomfortable issues more approachable, he creates stunning work that can at first glance be beautiful and at the same time haunting in it's message and execution.

From doing campaign artwork for Bernie Sanders, environmentally conscious pieces for architectural digest, and massive Trump protest murals on the sides of buildings, Auerbach has honed his artistry and angst to create a dialogue that has been heard and shown around the world.

'Let them hear your rebel yell, and long live The American Dreamer'

Known first for his iconic portraits of historical figures, Auerbach works with various acrylics, spray paint and inks, often over a canvas made of bullets, brick, relative newsprint collage, and other found objects. His deeply-held convictions led him to start making political work with one mission in mind: He felt a responsibility to connect people to the issues around them, and to express a gutteral stance in a way that was accessible to both the casual onlooker and those that delve deeper.

Auerbach's perspective and artwork was especially effective while working with the Bernie Sanders campaign. The campaign used the two pieces that Greg had created to help raise campaign funding, while the original pieces toured with the campaign around the country. Auerbach also personally sent over 20,000 posters and banners to supporters around the country to help raise awareness for the campaign. The banner was featured on CNN while introducing Senator Sanders for on of the primary debates.




