Roy Rogers is considered one of the world’s premier slide guitarists performing today. With 8 Grammy nominations to his credit, he is an internationally acclaimed musician and producer having produced John Lee Hooker and Ramblin’ Jack Elliott. His previous collaborative efforts include work with Norton Buffalo, Shana Morrison and Ray Manzarek. Most notably ‘Translucent Blues’, recorded with Manzarek, reached #1 on the Americana Roots Charts in 2012 and debuted on Billboards Blues Chart at #6. As a product of the San Francisco music scene Rogers’ roots are firmly planted in the blues. Artists with whom he has performed are Bonnie Raitt, Steve Miller and Sammy Hagar among many others. He is well known for his riveting live performances with his band, **The Delta Rhythm Kings**, consistently stretching the boundaries with his slide guitar.

Throughout 2014, on limited selected dates, RR & DRK will feature the artistry of **Carlos Reyes**. The chemistry between Roy & Carlos and the band is something to behold.

Carlos Reyes is an internationally renowned harpist and violinist. Born in Paraguay, he moved to the U.S. at an early age already deemed a child prodigy. He established himself in the Bay Area as one of the premier performing artists on his instruments. Classically trained and with multitudes of credits, Carlos transcends any specific style. He combines Latin elements with jazz and blues as well as other world music genres. He has performed with artists such as Chuck Magione, John Handy, Auturo Sandoval, as well as the Doobie Brothers and Steve Miller. Carlos brings his great passion for music to combine with the slide guitar with Roy Rogers.
