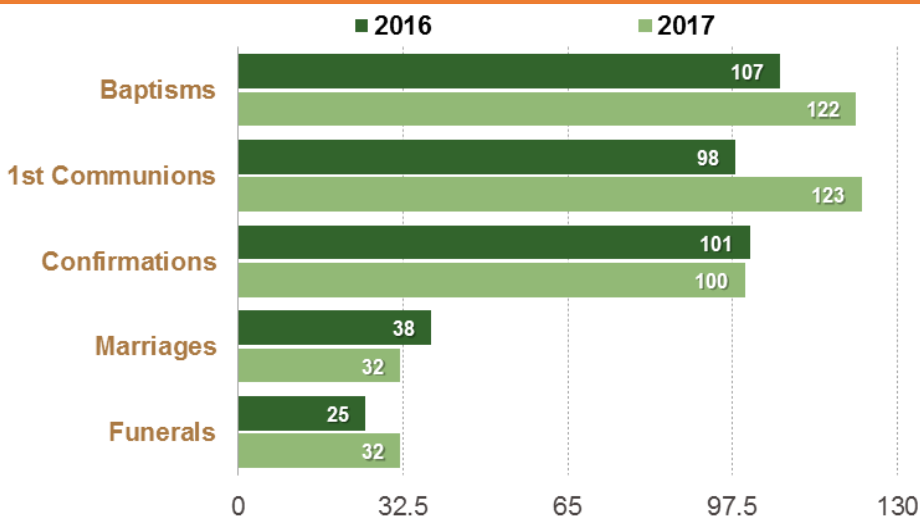


OLMC Pastoral Report 2017

Food for Families distributed 126,380 pounds of food, assisting 1690 families.

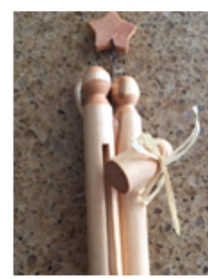

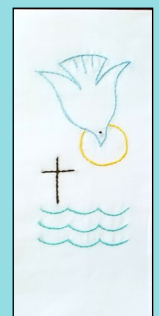

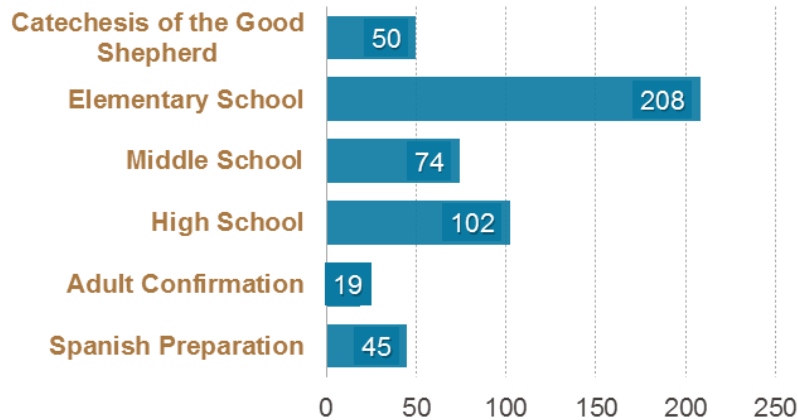
