



The Mission operates the **only** overnight men's and women's emergency shelter in Interior Alaska – and has a key role to play in the life of our Community.

Lives are changed at the Fairbanks Rescue Mission every day. These are men and women just like you and me, with families and children like ours. Somewhere, somehow, hard times came and they need a place to go for a helping hand.

Adult singles or families can stay at the Mission for up to 180 days. After the first 10 days (which are free), residents can either complete 2 hours of chores or pay \$12 a day. For the safety of our residents and staff we require all clients to be able to pass a breathalyzer test.

The Mission tries to meet both the spiritual and physical needs in helping individuals towards restoration – to a correct relationship with God and a productive relationship within our society. Long-term transformation is the Mission's goal.
