

Fairbanks Rescue Mission Services:

Emergency Shelter: A warm, safe, sober environment for individuals and families needing shelter.

Meals: Three free meals served daily for residents and anyone needing a hot meal.

Matthew 6:28 Clothing Closet: Clothing for men, women, and children are available to the general public and all items are free.

Veterans Program: This program provides wraparound services to help homeless Vets find employment, maintain stability, and develop a greater sense of self-determination.

Genesis Recovery Program: Residential addiction, recovery and relapse prevention program that stresses changing a person's heart, in order to change behavior.

Green Collar Job Training Program: Residents acquire job skills in our Recycling Center.

Chapel Services: Daily for residents and community.







Case Management: Provided for everyone who spends over 30 days in the shelter.

Case Management

Guidance to a better future.

As a member of the program we will be working with you to identify your barriers to employment, to set goals, to develop a timeline and to connect you to services that will help you gain employment and independent housing.

Jobs Training

Preparing you with the skills to succeed.

Throughout the program you will perform operations, receive on-the-job training with professional certificates, learn safety principles and job skills. The program utilizes phases to develop your skills and enhance your opportunities for future employment.

The principal goal of the Green Collar Jobs Program is to help our community's homeless and disadvantaged gain job skills and career counseling; however, from this goal stems the following positive outcomes:

Environmental:

Reduces the amount of waste entering our landfills

Conserves our natural resources

Reduces energy consumption and pollution

Social:

Provides job training and skill building for our community's homeless

Provides a free recycling service for local businesses and residents

Teaches the community about the merits of recycling and compassion for the disadvantaged

Economic:

Provides a small return for the Fairbanks Rescue Mission
