### WHO CAN APPLY?

Any emerging or mid career fine woodworking professional, (minimum of 4 years of experience) who will be working as an artist in residence, visiting scholar, or faculty collaborator at a nationally recognized Woodworking School or Arts and Crafts Center (starting date of residency no later than December 31, 2018)

*Foundation Board of Directors, Advisory Board, or Committee Members or members of their immediate families are not eligible for this award*

**APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL AUGUST 31, 2017**

for any residency that begins *no later than December 31, 2018*

Scholarship Committee Review and Recommendation by October 31, 2017

**RESUME**

**SUPPORTING FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS**

- Gross income from IRS Form 1040 or 1040 EZ for last year and the amount of other forms of support for that same year.
- Include sources such as parents, spousal support, grants, government aid, veteran's or Social Security benefits.

**TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**

Please have letters address the applicant's skill level and commitment to the woodworking profession

**DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS**

Show at least 3 woodworking projects or pieces of furniture that demonstrate the skill level and craftsmanship of the applicant.

- No more than two photographs per project
- Photos should not be larger than 1MB each
- All photos must be in JPEG format.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

Financial Need - 25%

Letter(s) of Recommendation - 15%

Demonstrated Craftsmanship/Talent - 30%

Relevance of Residency to Professional Goals - 30%
