The Austrian Economics Meeting Europe is an interdisciplinary conference, and as such, there is no set theme or field of study for submissions, as long as they stand broadly in the Austrian tradition. Previous presentations have covered a wide range of topics, from archaeology, history, philosophy, political sciences, and, of course, economics.
