- pH: 3.1

- Vines planted in 2001
- Vineyard soils: Ancient beach & diatomaceous earth, chert, limestone
- Pick date: August 23, 2014
- Brix at harvest: 20.3°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Whole-cluster direct-to-press
- Fermentation vessel: Stainless steel tank
- Bottled under crown cap at 2 brix to finish fermentation
- Native fermentation; bottle-conditioned
- No SO₂ added
- Unfined, unfiltered, not disgorged or cold-stabilized
- The Name: Each of our wines from Kick On Ranch bears a Latin name. *Cobolorum* means “goblin,” which is our affectionate nickname for the Riesling vines. We call it our naughty wine; it is extremely ebullient -- bubbles for days -- and needs to be chilled completely before serving. We recommend popping the crown cap over the sink with a glass in hand.
