



2014 “Nomine Amoris” Skin-Fermented Pinot Gris
Kick On Ranch Vineyard, Los Alamos, Santa Barbara County
23 cases produced



- ABV: 11.8%
- pH: 3.5
- TA: 0.58 g/100mL
- Vines planted in 2001
- Vineyard soils: Ancient beach & diatomaceous earth, chert, limestone
- Pick date: 8/15/14
- Brix at harvest: 20.2°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Destemmed, skin-fermented for native primary fermentation (7 days)
- Pressed to neutral French oak barrel after primary fermentation
- 5 months in barrel before bottling
- 30 ppm SO₂ in two additions after primary (the only additions of any kind)
- Unfined, unfiltered, not cold-stabilized
- Bottled Jan. 31, 2015
- The Name: Each of our wines from Kick On Ranch bears a Latin name. *Nomine Amoris* means “in the name of love.” Only Love is our motto in winemaking and life; we love the cool-climate, sandy Kick On Ranch Vineyard site so much that we make every variety they grow. We also love this Ramato-style expression of the Pinot Gris fruit.
