



2014 “Uncontainable” Vin Gris of Grenache
Santa Barbara Highlands Vineyard, Santa Barbara County
99 cases produced

- ABV: 13.2%
- pH: 3.34
- TA: 5.84 g/L
- Planted in 1999
- Vineyard soils: Fine sandy loam, mixed calcareous
- Clone: Grenache Noir, from the Mesa section of the vineyard
- Elevation: 3,200 feet (highest vineyard elevation in Santa Barbara County)
- Pick date: 8/23/14
- Brix at harvest: 22.2°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Lightly foot-treaded at the winery (by Emily) and direct-to-press; fermented in neutral French oak
- Native barrel fermentation for primary & malolactic
- 15 ppm SO₂ pre-bottling (the only addition of any kind)
- Racked once before bottling
- Unfined, unfiltered, not cold-stabilized
- Bottled June 2015
- The Name: The Uncontainable leaps out of the vineyard, and out of the glass. It does what it wishes, and we are mere bystanders to its whims. We make it because we must; we are compelled to explore all the iterations of Grenache from this vineyard.
