



2012 “Uncontainable” Vin Gris of Grenache
Santa Barbara Highlands Vineyard
Santa Barbara County
23 cases produced

- ABV: 12.78%
- pH: 3.26
- TA: 0.667 g/100mL
- Grenache Noir, planted in 2000
- Vineyard soils: Fine sandy loam, mixed calcareous
- Mesa block: 3,200 feet (highest vineyard elevation in Santa Barbara County)
- Pick date: 9/9/12
- Brix at harvest: 21°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Gentle foot tread; then whole-cluster pressed to neutral French oak
- Native barrel fermentation for primary & malolactic
- 5 months in neutral French oak
- 25ppm SO₂ after primary fermentation & 12ppm pre-bottling (the only additions of any kind)
- Unfined, unfiltered, not cold-stabilized
- Hand-bottled February 2013
