- Pick date: 8/28/13
- Brix at harvest: 21.3°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- 100 percent destemmed
- Native primary & malolactic fermentations
- 9 months aging in neutral French oak barrels
- Racked once before bottling
- 30ppm SO₂ pre-bottling (the only addition of any kind)
- Unfined & unfiltered
- Bottled June 16, 2014
- The Name: Each of our wines from Kick On Ranch bears a Latin name. “Audire” (pronounced *Aw-DEE-ray*) means “listen.” We strive to listen to the vineyard, the growing season, the fruit; we believe this wine has something to say.
