- ABV: 12.6%
- pH: 3.7
- TA: 0.715 g/100mL
- Syrah clone #877, planted in 2003
- Vineyard soils: Riverwash, fine & gravelly sandy loam
- Brix at harvest: 22°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Dry-farmed
- 100 percent whole-cluster fermented
- Punchdowns mostly by foot throughout native primary fermentation
- Native primary & malolactic fermentations
- 12 months aging in neutral French oak
- Racked once
- 30ppm SO₂ pre-bottling (the only addition of any kind)
- Unfined & unfiltered
- Hand-bottled November 2012
