



**2011 “Uncontainable” Vin Gris of Grenache**  
**Santa Barbara Highlands Vineyard**  
**Santa Barbara County**  
**23 cases produced**

- ABV: 12.4%
- pH: 3.12
- TA: 0.894 g/100mL
- Grenache Noir, planted in 2000
- Vineyard soils: Fine sandy loam, mixed calcareous
- Mesa block: 3,200 feet (highest vineyard elevation in Santa Barbara County)
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- Gentle foot tread; then whole-cluster pressed to neutral French oak
- Native barrel fermentation for primary & malolactic
- 5 months in neutral French oak
- 25ppm SO<sub>2</sub> after primary fermentation & 12ppm pre-bottling (the only additions of any kind)
- Unfined, unfiltered, not cold-stabilized
- Hand-bottled February 2012
