- Syrah clone #877, planted in 2003
- Vineyard soils: Riverwash, fine & gravelly sandy loam
- Pick date: 9/13/13
- Brix at harvest: 22.7°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- 100 percent destemmed
- Punchdowns mostly by foot throughout primary fermentation
- Native primary & malolactic fermentations
- 16 months aging in a 600-L neutral French oak demi-muid
- Racked once before bottling
- 30ppm SO<sub>2</sub> pre-bottling (the only addition of any kind)
- Unfined & unfiltered
- Bottled January 31, 2014
- The name: *La Belle Rêveuse* - The Beautiful Dreamer. Syrah was one of the varieties we worked with when we first made our own wine; and so the dream became reality.
