- Vineyard soils: Riverwash, fine & gravelly sandy loam
- Pick date: September 8, 2015
- Brix at harvest: 24°
- Hand-picked at sunrise
- 100 percent whole-cluster
- Punchdowns mostly by foot throughout primary fermentation
- Native primary & malolactic fermentations
- 11 months aging in neutral French oak
- Racked once before bottling
- 20ppm SO₂ pre-bottling (the only addition of any kind)
- Unfined & unfiltered
- Bottled August 3, 2016
- The name: *La Belle Rêveuse* - The Beautiful Dreamer. Syrah was one of the varieties we worked with when we first made our own wine; and so the dream became reality.
