Isaiah 9:1-7

1. What are some of your Christmas traditions and how does surprise play a part?

2. Since the “zeal of the Lord will do it,” how can we be confident in final completion of the promise?

It is by his passion for his people that the promise will be kept - we need not wonder if our own effort play in. Since he has been faithful to this point we can be confident that he will finish what he has begun.
