“Unity in Opportunity and Opposition”

1 Corinthians 16:1-11

1. How much money do you make? (Just kidding!) What is it about money that turns us secretive and inwardly concerned?

It reveals so much about us, and is something we don't think other people have a right to engage about or know etc.

2. How does the truth of the Bible and the gospel specifically shift how we view money and the things we own?

We gain a changed perspective on ownership; trusting the God provides, gifts us what we need. And then we live holding it all loosely because it is a gift to us.

3. What do we do to keep “developing virtue” and forming healthy habits from becoming a new law for us?

Consistently check our motivation. If I am doing it prove something I have moved into the wrong perspective. But if I like motivated by the grace we have been given the habits should be healthy.

4. What if the indicators of being gospel formed are not present? What do we do if we are not generous, supportive and safe as individuals and as a church?

We go back to the gospel, make sure we are hearing it, seeing it and rehearsing it with others, praying that it will transform us.
