Project #H.005734 LA 447 CORRIDOR STUDY, Add environmental phase at a cost of \$601K STPFLEX at 80/20 in FFY 2015

Project #H.009956 LA 44: TURN LANES AND MEDIANS, (Cost changes), ROW phase is now \$4M HSIP funds at 90/10 in FFY 2015, Utility phase is now \$2M HSIP funds at 90/10 in FFY 2015, Construction phase is now \$2.8M HSIP funds at 90/10 in FFY 2016

Project #H.010439 BOYD ST & 21ST PUMPING STA IMP I-110, Add engineering phase at a cost of \$231K NHPP funds at 90/10 in FFY 2015

Project #H.010655 LA 1 LIGHTING RENOVATIONS, Project cancelled – remove from TIP

Project #H.972089 HQ DISABILITY ACCESS FOR SIDEWALKS, Add Feasibility phase at a cost of \$300k STPFLEX funds at 80/20 in FFY 2015
