

MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2014.009

RELATING TO OFFENSES; AMENDING TOWN CODE SECTION 11-5-3 (NOISE STANDARDS IN THE RESORT AND RECREATION ZONE) TO CLARIFY A PROVISION REGARDING NOISE STANDARDS FOR SPECIAL EVENTS; AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the Town Council is authorized by A.R.S. § 9-240 to define, abate and remove nuisances and to prevent, suppress and punish any riot, rout, affray, disorderly noise or disturbance in any public or private place within the town; and

WHEREAS the Town Council finds that the revisions to the Marana Town Code set forth in this ordinance are in the best interests of the Town of Marana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Marana Town Code Section 11-5-3 (Noise standards in the resort and recreation zone) is hereby amended as follows (with deletions shown with ~~strikeouts~~ and additions shown with double underlining):

11-5-3 Noise standards in the resort and recreation zone

[Paragraphs A through D remain unchanged]

E. Exemptions. The following activities shall be exempt from these noise standards:

1. Special events pursuant to an approved special ~~use~~ event permit. Noise impacts shall be evaluated and conditioned as part of the special ~~use~~ event permit process as set forth in chapter 10-6.

[Subparagraphs E.2 through E.5 and paragraphs F through L remain unchanged]

SECTION 2. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions of the Council in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of

competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day after its adoption.


