

**RIGHT-OF-WAY
PERMIT**

Permission is hereby granted to [insert name of permit holder] for use of the Town of Marana public Right(s)-of-Way as described on Right-of-Way Permit Application No. [insert the application number] and all attachments, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 12-7 of the Marana Town Code.

The holder of this permit, **MUST** at all times, ensure that all excavations, construction and/or other operations performed within the Town conform to all applicable Town of Marana requirements pertaining to the type of work permitted, including, but not limited to, providing adequate barricades with warning lights for dark hours at all times around and adjacent to all excavations, holes, earth mounds, or rubble piles, and keeping sidewalks clear of all dirt, stones, and other construction litter.

The permit holder must give the Town's Department of Public Works timely notice of readiness for inspections, defined as a **minimum of 24 hours in advance**.

The permit holder, upon order from the Town of Marana, shall perform necessary maintenance and assume all responsibility for the Right(s)-of-Way repair described herein.

PERMIT INFORMATION:

Permit(s) can be extended or renewed once for no charge.

Right-Of-Way Access Permits have a thirty day (30) expiration period, and thirty days (30) for each extension unless approved by Robert Rose, Right-of-Way Inspector

Construction permits have up to a ninety (90) expiration period, depending on project.
