

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS | TANGERINE CORRIDOR PARK PROJECT

### GENERAL QUESTIONS

- When will construction of the park begin?
  - Currently, we anticipate construction to begin sometime between spring and fall of 2016.
- What will operating hours be at the new park?
  - Like other Town parks, we expect park hours to be between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m.
- How long will the park project take to complete?
  - In general, an 11 to 12 acre park takes about 9 months to complete, but several factors such as special permits, weather, and unforeseen geographical issues can prolong construction.
- Will the new park have lights?
  - Park user safety is an important design consideration and lighting can be expected around active park features, sidewalks, restrooms and parking lot. When it comes to lighting, there are several low emitting, dark sky lighting options that could be explored. Lighting active park features such as courts is an option for Marana community parks and is highly recommended since many of these amenities are best enjoyed during cooler evening hours in the summer months. Court lights can be operated by a timer system and set to not turn on after park hours.
- Will the new park have lighted sports fields?
  - This park is too small to accommodate lighted sport fields.
- Is there going to be a walking path at this park and will it be lighted?
  - Community Parks often have walking paths and paved paths are typically lit for security while natural paths are not.
- Will there be a splash pad at the new park?
  - A splash pad is not currently on the list of park features considered conducive to this site
- Why can't the park site be left as natural, open space?
  - This park will have substantial natural area set-backs on its north side along Tangerine Road and south along Camino de Manana. Additionally, retaining the natural landscape is an important design objective.
