

## FURNITURE ROOM AT THE BARGAIN BASEMENT

Starting January 19<sup>th</sup> we will have a room for small furniture and small appliances. Here are the regulations that we will follow to accept these items.

1. No big items. Nothing heavier than one average sized woman can move. The items must be moved into the furniture room by the consignor.
2. No large appliances, no TVs, no heavy gym equipment, no large furniture, no mattresses or box springs, no bed frames (only small metal frames that fold down), no stereos, no computers or computer components.
3. All items consigned must be clean and in good repair or will not be accepted.
4. All electronic appliances and devices must be demonstrated to staff that they are operational or they will NOT BE accepted for consignment. Battery operated devices must have active batteries.
5. Examples of appropriate items that we will consign are:
  - A. Kitchen and dining room chairs
  - B. Occasional chairs (i.e. small rockers) – one person can move
  - C. End tables
  - D. Coffee tables
  - E. Floor lamps and table lamps (must have light bulbs)
  - F. Appliances that can sit on a table (microwaves, crock pots etc.)
  - G. Bar stools
  - H. Two drawer file cabinets
  - I. Small book cases if not heavy
  - J. Shelving if not heavy
  - K. Small area rugs
6. We will consign these items for 30 days the same as our contract states. After 30 days you must remove these items if you want them back or they will become the property of the Bargain Basement. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
7. We would like the consignor to price their furniture with a limit of \$50.00 per item, if it is worth that amount. We try to keep things affordable in the Bargain Basement to make it easy to sell and help people in the community.
