Question: What or who is Second Chance?

Answer: Second Chance is a non-profit organization program serving adults with brain injuries in Bay, Calhoun, Washington, Gulf, Jackson, and Holmes Counties. We offer a day program Monday thru Friday.

Question: What services do you provide?

Question: Who is eligible?

Answer: Adults for age 18 and up who have either incurred a traumatic or acquired brain injury and reside in our coverage area.

Question: How much does membership to Second Chance cost?

Answer: The three day per week membership fee is \$50/month. The five day per week fee is \$75/month. It has and continues to be the policy that no membership request be denied on the inability to pay this fee. Scholarships are available at this time for persons in need of assistance.
