FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING
STAY

On February 26, 2016, the Honorable Robert S. Lasnik appointed the undersigned to serve as a settlement judge and to decide any additional requests for a stay. Although the City is not an active participant in the settlement process, it appears that a solution to the siting issue of the proposed telecommunication tower may be close. However, any such agreement would have to proceed through a city land use permit process.


