



June 2-3, 2018

Four times in the New Testament the Apostle Paul encourages believers to pray continuously or constantly (Romans 12:12; Colossians 4:2; Ephesians 6:18; I Thessalonians 5:17). This challenge has befuddled many Christians over the years – how is it possible? If you try, you soon encounter challenges. You start repeating yourself. Your mind wanders. You get bored and exhausted. You give up, sometimes feeling like you have failed. That is not what God intended.

Understanding the journey to constant prayer requires us to examine other scriptures. Jesus gives us a key insight when he tells his disciples: when you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, because they think they will be heard because of their many words (Matthew 6:7). Then later Jesus promised that He would send the Spirit to abide in us, comfort us, and speak to us (John 14:16; 15:26; 16:13). That is why Paul urges us to pray in the Spirit at all times (Ephesians 6:18). And in Romans 8:26 we read: the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words... the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

These scriptures reveal that "constant prayer" is not possible by human effort alone. It requires trusting that the Holy Spirit is praying in us and for us, whether or not words are coming out of our mouths! Spirit-led prayer can then begin by acknowledging and resting in His presence (see Psalm 131). Like two lovers sitting by a fireplace or taking a walk together outdoors, God wants us to enjoy His nearness. We can ask the Spirit to inspire our human prayers. When we do, we can experience a

glimpse of what we will enjoy for eternity – unbroken fellowship with God.

- Take some time to simply sit quietly, acknowledging and welcoming God's presence. Thank Jesus that His salvation for you is secured, and that He will "never leave nor forsake you." Thank the Holy Spirit for His presence in you and the others in this room. Surrender your anxiety to Him and ask Him to lead you in prayer.
- Take time to thank the Holy Spirit for His guidance during the Bethany 2023 process and the clarity of findings.
- 3. Prayer items:
 - That the Elders will be bold in following the Holy Spirit's leading as we apply the findings of Bethany 2023 in future decision-making.
 - Thanks for all the fruitful ministries and activities at our church in the past year – for faithful volunteers and leaders, and transformed lives in our midst.
 - For those suffering or struggling with physical and emotional and relational challenges, and 'time of life' pressures and worries.
 - That the summer months may provide rest and refreshment for those whose lives are stressful and busy.
 - That good decisions be made regarding future ministry and event planning.
 - That God will lead us in the launching of our search committee in the Fall, and that He would lead us to our next Senior Pastor.


A Brief History...

BETHANY CHAPEL began in 1950 when a few families moved from an established Christian Brethren Assembly at "6th Avenue Gospel Hall" to the southwest of Calgary in order to establish a new church work. Bethany's first senior pastor, Dr. Gary Inrig came to us in 1972, and was with the church for seventeen years until God called him elsewhere in 1989. We have met in various locations over the years: St. Mark's Hall near 14 St & 26 Ave SW, and 2323 Osbourne Crescent. Growth necessitated the use of a local school symnasium in 1976!


Our present church building at 3333 Richardson Way was built in 1985 and the CE wing was added in 1988. From 1990 to 1997 our senior pastor was Dr. Steve Breedlove followed by Alan Palmer, from 1998 to 2001 and, Dr. Preston Busch, from 2002 - 2017, and we have had our Transitional Pastor John Prociuk since mid-2017.


The faithfulness of God is evident in the history of Bethany Chapel. Thank you for joining with us to celebrate His work amongst us over the last 68 years!
