An opportunity currently exists in the Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (OHSP) within the *unclassified service* for a candidate who meets the minimum job requirements specified below:

TITLE: Software Development Specialist 2

SALARY: \$67,714.29 - \$96,415.56

LOCATION: Hamilton, New Jersey

JOB DESCRIPTION: Under the direction of the Chief Technology Officer, is responsible for the development, oversight and implementation of multiple database/programming systems for delivery to the law enforcement community in the prevention and deterrence of terrorist-related activities. The incumbent will assess the client's needs, create programming modules using J2EE, Java, JSON, Spring, AJAX, CSS, JavaScript, HTML, JQuery, Hibernate, Eclipse (or other IDE), and Spring technologies. Should have strong SQL skills and experience writing stored procedures, preferably in Oracle PL/SQL. Knowledge of a reporting tool like Crystal Reports is desired. Perform test-beds, modify programs as required and train users on system applications. Additionally, the incumbent will assist with the preparation of budget projections for program support, serve as a liaison with various law enforcement officials, county terrorism coordinators, public entities and private sector heads, assist with helpdesk activities, and participate on various committees as well as representing the Office at terrorism and preparedness related technology meetings.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

Experience: Two (2) years of programming, systems analysis, or computer analysis experience.

Note: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (3) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

Note: A Master's degree in an Information Technology field may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.


