Conditions on CBRNE/HazMat Grant Funding

The purpose of this special condition is to maintain standardized countywide Hazardous Material (HazMat) and CBRNE (chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive) emergency response capability, capacity and competence. As a condition of utilizing any HSGP funding on CBRNE/HazMat investment, the subrecipient agrees to follow the requirements identified below:

Each subrecipient shall enter into written agreements with recognized HazMat service providers, if applicable, to reflect adequate county CBRNE capacity, competency and coordination. These agreements must be updated as warranted.

Each subrecipient will review and revise the EOP as necessary to reflect any significant changes, as indicated in #1 above.

The governing body of each subrecipient must enter into a statewide mutual aid agreement provided by the State, which allows its HazMat service providers to respond to out-of-county incidents, subject to availability of resources.

Each subrecipient must operate under the National Incident Management System.

Each subrecipient must utilize funds to meet and then exceed the standards found in the 2007 (or its successor) N.J. Division of State Police guidance document "Hazmat Emergency Response Teams Standards for Operations and Training."

Adequately trained and equipped personnel will respond to HazMat and CBRNE emergencies and conduct investigations as requested by NJDEP in coordination with DHSS, and/or the N.J. Division of State Police (DSP). Such response activities may include responding to emergencies outside of the geographical jurisdiction of the teams at the request of NJDEP and/or DSP. HazMat and emergency response activities will be conducted in accordance with the approved subrecipient EOP, with the NJDEP Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E, applicable PEOSH requirements and the above-referenced DSP guidance document.

All subrecipients agree to participate in regional CBRNE exercises with the State Office of Emergency Management and send a representative to attend any subsequent debriefing meeting(s).

All subrecipients must agree to maintain all equipment purchased with these grant funds in accordance with specifications provided by the manufacturer.
