An opportunity currently exists in the Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (OHSP) within the *unclassified service* for a candidate who meets the minimum job requirements specified below:

JOB DESCRIPTION: The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (OHSP) is seeking a full-time employee to serve as the Director of the New Jersey Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Cell (NJCCIC) at the New Jersey Regional Operations Intelligence Center (NJROIC).

As Director of the State's Information Sharing and Analysis Organization (ISAO), the successful candidate will oversee the activities of the NJCCIC's three branches – Operations, Analysis, and Partnerships – to ensure proper alignment with Executive Order 178 and Presidential Executive Order 13691. In addition to managing the implementation of technology solutions to enhance the State's collection and automated dissemination of raw and finished cyber threat intelligence, the Director serves as a liaison with state, federal, and non-profit counterparts including but not limited to the National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center (NCCIC), Fusion Centers, Information Sharing and Analysis Centers (ISAC), and other Information Sharing and Analysis Organizations (ISAO). The Director is also responsible for managing the alignment of the NJCCIC's standard operating procedures (SOP) with the NJROIC's SOP, to including integrating the NJCCIC's activities into the State Emergency Operations Plan.

Competitive candidates are comfortable with routinely alternating between technical and non-technical disciplines and articulating New Jersey's cyber threat landscape across the law enforcement, homeland security, emergency management, and information technology spectrum.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

Experience: Three (3) years of experience in the cyber threat intelligence and incident response field, to include experience and proficiency with Security Information and Event Management (SIEM) and automated indicator sharing (AIS).

License: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

Applicants should be aware that all OHSP employees must be a U. S. Citizen due to the fact that they need to be eligible to obtain a Secret or Top Secret Clearance from the federal government. U. S. Citizenship is a requirement for obtaining such clearance. Additionally, a criminal background investigation is conducted on all OHSP personnel.

In accordance with the New Jersey First Act P.L. 2011 c70, effective September 1, 2011, new public employees are required to obtain New Jersey residency within one (1) year of employment.
