



CASE STUDY

On June 12, the deadliest mass shooting in US history took place at Pulse nightclub in Orlando, Florida. This was the first ideological mass shooting this year.

- A lone gunman conducted an attack which killed 49 people and injured 53.
- During the standoff with police, the gunman called 9-1-1 pledging his allegiance to the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria.



Ideological - An incident in which an ideologically motivated offender(s) kills or attempts to kill three or more victims with a firearm in one or more locations in close geographical proximity.

Non-Ideological - An incident in which an offender(s) kills or attempts to kill three or more victims with a firearm in one or more locations in close geographical proximity. *This excludes criminal activity and domestic violence.*
